MINIMUM YEARS OF STUDY PRIOR TO APPLICATION:

Four

YEARS OF STUDY FOLLOWING ADMISSION:

Four-year degree program plus a minimum of two years of post-graduate studies

To be considered for admission, applicants must have been awarded a four-year baccalaureate degree prior to entry into Medicine and must meet the MCAT requirement prior to application. Specific courses will not be required but are recommended only. A competitive average for admission will be calculated using all courses taken and must be no lower than 75% for consideration. A complete listing of the admission requirements for the College of Medicine can be found at medicine.usask.ca/admissions.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Ranking for admission for Saskatchewan residents is based on academic performance (30%), MCAT (20%), and personal qualities (50%). In addition, three supervisory references must be provided. The Admissions Committee will also carry out a file review on all applications with an emphasis on professionalism issues and consistent academic performance.
