To be considered for admission, applicants must complete a minimum of 30 credit units of university-level course work prior to April 30 of the application year and must attain a minimum weighted average of 70%. Acceptance into the Bachelor of Science in Nutrition (B.Sc.[Nutr.]) is based on the calculated postsecondary admission average (60%), Test of Critical Skills (30%) and personal video interview (10%).
