PATHWAYS TO MEDICINE

INDIGENOUS ADMISSIONS PROGRAM

Through the College of Medicine Indigenous Admissions Program, people of Indigenous (Métis, Inuit and First Nations) ancestry can apply for admission to the Medical Doctor (MD) program of study. Ten per cent of the positions available in the MD degree program each year are specifically for applicants of Indigenous ancestry. The program supports growth in the number of Indigenous people becoming doctors in Saskatchewan.

INDIGENOUS STUDENT MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

Opportunities exist for mentorship with a physician, current medical students, and/or others.
