The University of Saskatchewan College of Medicine values and supports admitting individuals of Indigenous ancestry to Saskatchewan's Medical School.

Applicants to the MD program must be awarded a 4-year baccalaureate degree prior to entry into Medicine. The MD degree takes four years to complete and includes the study of both basic medical sciences and practical training in hospitals and other clinical sites.
