

# Undergraduate Certificate in Sustainability Award for Outstanding Sustainability in Action Project

**Eligibility**

All projects completed as part of ENVS 401/EVSC 485 during the academic year (September–April) in which nominations are solicited are eligible to be considered for the award. Students whose projects are nominated must successfully complete the course for the project to be eligible for this award.

**Nominations**

Self-nominations and nominations from peers, faculty, or other university members familiar with the project will all be considered. The Nominator must complete the following form that details how the project exemplifies excellence in each of the areas identified as evaluation criteria for the award. Additional letters of support for the nomination may also be submitted where deemed appropriate by the nominator.
