The Online Application Guide is designed to assist you in applying to the College of Dentistry, University of Saskatchewan. Along the way you will find helpful instructions, hints and notes on how to successfully submit your application. Thank you for considering the College of Dentistry.

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- The College of Dentistry accepts online applications only
- You will receive a confirmation email from us within
   48 hours of submitting your application
- You can save your progress and complete your application in more than one sitting
- You are required to monitor the status of your application after it has been submitted to view outstanding items
- You must pay the \$208 application fee online by Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover


If you are currently or will be enrolled in any prerequisite courses during the 2025-2026 academic



  - If you are offered admission, ONE final and complete official transcript will be due no later than June 5.
- Submit acceptance form, tuition deposit and Criminal Record Check by deadlines stated in offer letter
  - To accept an offer of admission, applicants must pay a non-refundable deposit of 15% of tuition by the deadline stated in the offer letter. The deposit will be applied towards tuition fees at the time of registration.
