**Fall 2025 Entry**

Effective Fall 2025 entry (application deadline Dec 1, 2024), the WCVM prerequisites will include a 3-credit (one-term) Indigenous/Native studies university-level course. This course must have a focus on teaching the historical context and effects of colonialism on Indigenous people in Canada.
