

Situational Judgment Test (SJT) – Casper
- Fall 2024 Entry -

Effective fall 2024 entry, all applicants applying to the WCVM's DVM Program are required to complete the [Casper](#) Situational Judgment Test through Acuity Insights. The following test dates are acceptable for Fall 2024 entry:

- July 20th, 2023 8pm ET
- August 8th, 2023 5pm ET
- August 29th, 2023 5pm ET
- September 14th, 2023 8pm ET
- October 5th, 2023 8pm ET
- October 12th, 2023 5pm ET
- October 19th, 8pm ET
- November 23rd, 2023 5pm ET
- December 7th, 2023 8pm ET
- January 10th, 2024 8pm ET
- January 25th, 2024 5pm ET

[Casper](#) is a 90-110 minute online, open-response situational judgment test that measures competencies and attributes that we believe are important for successful students and graduates of the DVM program. **Note:** The Duet assessment offered through Acuity Insights is **not** required.

How to complete the assessments:

In order to take Casper, you will need the following:

- Government-issued photo ID (English/French) for account sign up and validation
 - Valid email address (same email used for your WCVM application)
 - Desktop or laptop computer
 - Working webcam
 - Working microphone
 - Reliable high-speed internet connection with at least 1.5 Mbps and upload speed of at least 2 Mbps
1. Sign up at Acuity Insights Assessments at www.acuityinsights.app for **CSP-10201 – Canadian Professional Health Sciences**, after choosing your specific country, language, program and school.
 2. Select a Casper test date using an email address that you check regularly and that you used, or will use, for your WCVM application; there may be updates to the test schedule.
Important: To account for identity verification and payment processing timelines, ensure that you **register for your test at least 3 days before your preferred test date and time**. Last-minute bookings are not recommended.
 3. Ensure you select **University of Saskatchewan, Western College of Veterinary Medicine** for distribution.

Accommodations: Applicants requiring testing accommodations to complete their Acuity Insights Assessments should submit an Initial Request Form (Part 1 and 2) at least four (4) weeks prior to their scheduled Casper test date. Casper can only be completed once per admissions cycle, i.e., 2023-24, and test results are only valid for the admissions cycle in which the test is taken. Applicants who have taken Casper in previous years are required to re-take it to be eligible for subsequent admission cycle(s).

Please note that the WCVM does not process Casper results until February; therefore, this will not be updated as received on the application status panel until that time.
